In addition we will be reviewing band scholarship applications and start planning for next year. With summer just around the corner it is time to begin to think about Band Camp, the Dates are August 14 – 20, if you have a child in either Symphony or Concert Band you will need to plan your summer accordingly, if you have a child that is in Varsity Band I will let students know who was selected to attend Band Camp, in early June. BAND CAMP 2007 REGISTRATION

Band Camp Registration takes place during the spring of the school year. Current Pioneer students receive the enrollment form from Mr. Leach or Ms. Waring in the classroom. Band Camp Registration Forms for 2007-08 will be available in the Pioneer Band Room beginning on MONDAY, Mar 12. Forms & Fees can be turned in at any time, but the final deadline is May 14, 2007. NOTE: If current students are picking up forms for incoming 9th grade siblings/neighbors/friends, make sure to use the "INCOMING STUDENT" form!

Incoming 9th grade students receive the forms when they audition for Mr. Leach at their middle school. Forms are also available at the Incoming 9th Grade Orientation meeting immediately following Bands In Review. Forms and deposits can be returned to the directors in the classroom or mailed to the address provided on the form.

From the PTO Thrift Shop:

- You can work at the Thrift Shop this summer! It is open year-round and needs volunteers every month. Remember to turn in your requests for each month by the first Saturday of the previous month (e.g. by May 5th for June, etc). If you are not sure how to turn in your requests, call the Thrift Shop at 996-9155.
- You can start earning credits toward either Band Camp 2008 or the Concert Band and Symphony Band trips for the 2007-2008 school year. Just sign in on a sheet marked *Pioneer Band Camp 2008* or *Pioneer Band trip 2008*. Remember hat the first 4 hours worked will go toward the general Band program, and there is also a sign-sheet for that.
- If you missed being on the schedule for a certain month, you can always call and ask if there are openings/cancellations. That would be a good way to get your 4 hours in for the Band program.
- Any hours worked from now until August 31st will be "paid out" the beginning of September. If you are working toward Band Camp 2007, you will have already paid for Band Camp by that time. However, you will be reimbursed whatever money you earn, up to the amount you have paid in for Band Camp.
